Colonel Neely was assigned to Battery B, 1st Training Battalion, United States Army Training Center at Fort Sill after graduating from Artillery Officer Candidate School.

He left active duty after two years and served in a variety of assignments with the U.S. Army Reserve Control Group and the 91st Division (Training). Assignments during this period included Battery FDO, 6th Battalion, 83rd Artillery, Fort Lewis, Washington, Platoon Leader and Training Officer with the 361st Regiment, 91st Division, Training Officer and later Commander, Company C, 2nd Battalion, 362nd Regiment, 91st Division.

He later served with the 3rd Battalion, 197th Field Artillery, New Hampshire Army National Guard as a Service Battery and later Firing Battery Commander. Assignments at Battalion level included Motor Officer, S-1, S-2, S-3, and Executive Officer. While assigned to the State Area Command, New Hampshire National Guard he served as the Civilian Personnel Management Officer and Chief POMMS Division. He later served as the 197th Field Artillery Brigade Executive Officer and then commanded the 3rd Battalion.

Colonel Neely was next assigned to Headquarters, State Area Command, New Hampshire Army National Guard, where he served as Executive Officer and later the Inspector General for the New Hampshire National Guard. He culminated his career with the U.S. Army Reserve. His decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal.
