2 FROM N. Y. DIE IN ARMY PLANE

Fort Jackson, S. C., Aug. 12 (AP).—
Two New York officers were killed late yesterday when a small artillery observation plane crashed about two miles east of the field here.

The dead were: Second Lieut. Andrew R. Telko, whose mother is Mrs. Rose Hanych of 7 Hamilton Ave., Yonkers, N. Y., and Second Lieut. Donald O'Grady, whose mother is Mrs. Maud O'Grady of 2507 Washington Ave., New York City.
