Colonel O'Keeffe was commissioned Signal Corps upon completion of Field Artillery OCS. After attending Signal OBC he served as Automated Data Processing Plans Officer at the Automated Logistics Management Agency at St. Louis. During a tour in Vietnam he was the Chief of Computer Operations at the Long Binh Inventory Control Center.

During an assignment to the 78th Division (Training) at Camp New Jersey he served as the Adjutant General Advisor/Augmentee. His next duty assignment was as the Instructor/Chairman of the Computer Science Department of the Department of Defense Computer Institute. In Germany he served with Headquarters Central Army Group and Command and Control Support Activity, Europe. He later served as the Chief, Embedded Material Command. Division. Systems Army Subsequent assignments included Program Manager of the Theater Automated Command and Control Information Management System in Korea and Worldwide Military Command and Control System Program Manager at the Defense Information Systems Agency. His career culminated as the Deputy Program Executive, Standard Army Management Information Systems, Fort Belvoir, Virginia.
