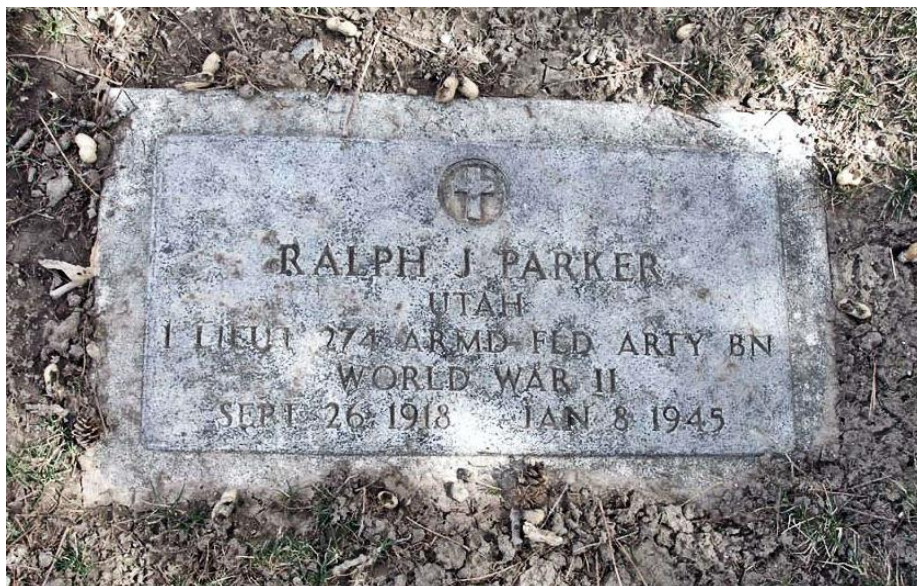

(Citation Needed): Ralph J. Parker, United States Army, is reported to have been awarded the Silver Star under the below-listed General Orders for conspicuous gallantry and intrepidity in action against the enemy while serving with the 274th Armored Field Artillery Battalion during World War II.

General Orders: Headquarters, VII Corps, General Orders No. 32 (1945)
