Colonel Pepeta's initial assignment after Officer Candidate School was with the 510th Field Artillery Battalion in Salzburg, Austria where he served as a Forward Observer. He later served as the Property Disposal Officer with the 7690 Headquarters and Service Company in Vienna. He returned to the 510th Field Artillery after the unit re-located to Baumholder, Germany and served again as a Forward Observer/Aerial Observer.

He then joined the Army Reserves where he served in a variety of assignments to include Gunnery Officer with Battery C, 317th AAA Battalion, command of Battery B, 317th AAA Battalion, Missile Officer, Battalion Adjutant and S-3 with the 329th Ordinance Battalion, and an assignment as the Assistant S-3 4830 Engineer Battalion at Fort Rodman, Massachusetts.

After transferring to the Medical Service Corps, he served as Supply Officer at the 455th General Hospital in Warwick, Rhode Island and later as the Medical Branch Team Chief, 765th Division Maneuver Training Command, Warwick Rhode Island. His career culminated as the Operations Officer, 1114th Military Intelligence Group, Fort Rodman, Massachusetts.

Colonel Repeta's decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster and the Army Achievement Medal.
