Only saw him one time about an hour before he died. At the time I thought "he looks like a fine man and a good officer." Just the way he was interacting with the troops. I was happy he was along as an artillery FO. He must have been at the head of the column when he and the platoon sergeant were killed by a .51 caliber machine gun. One of my friends, Stan Frew, tried to get his body, but to no avail. For the rest of the day my Company tried to recover the bodies, but we kept getting ambushed and lost a lot of men. Rest in Peace!
