My husband, Jerry Bradford, was in Vietnam with B Battery 6th Bn, 77 Arty.

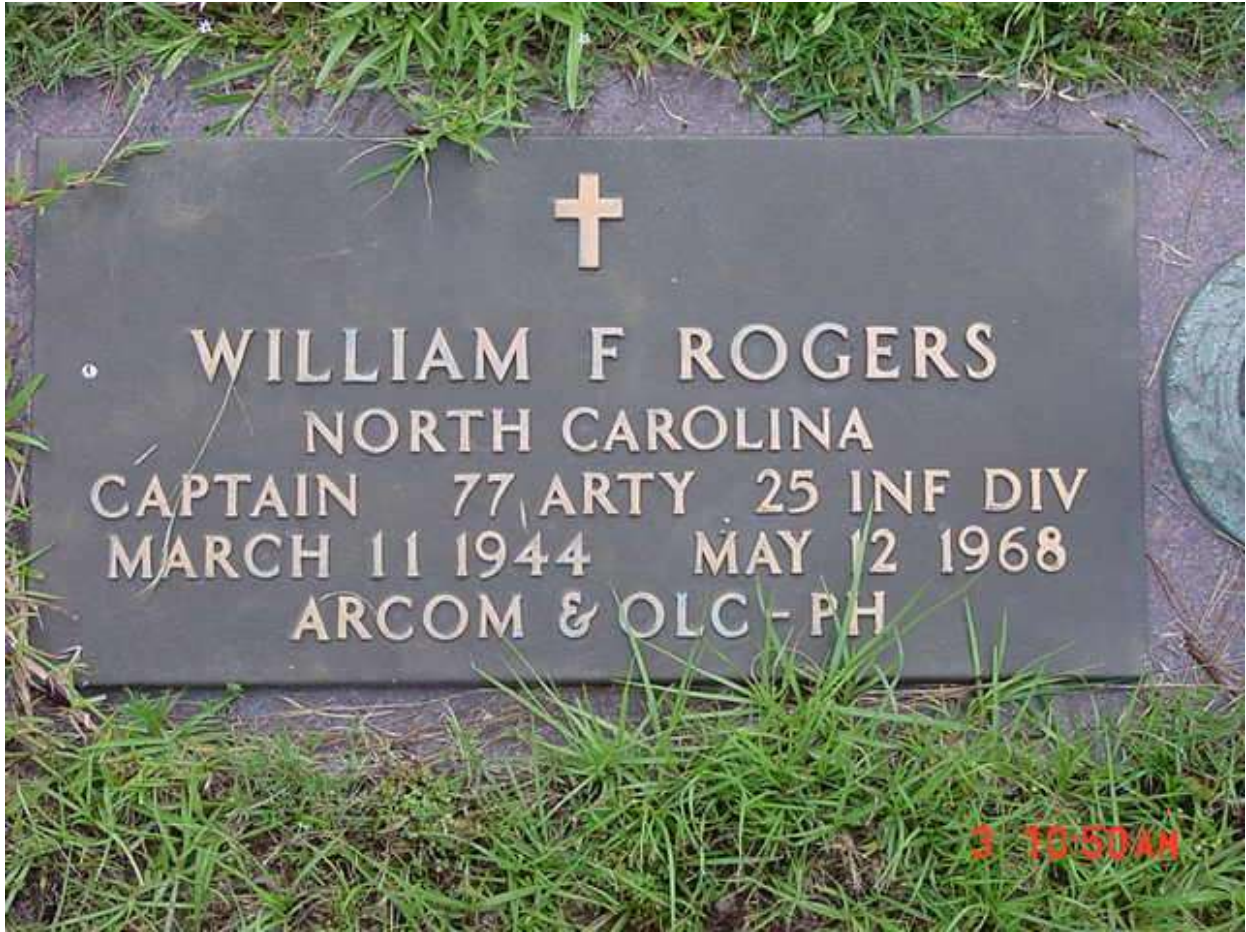
He often told of an Army Capt that caught a shell in the armhole of his flak jacket on May 12, 1968 (Mother's Day) during heavy fire and heavy casualties.

The blast blew Jerry backward. The Army Captain was down.

Jerry helped carry the Captain into a bunker then went back to the battle.
