Lieutenant Schnebly was graduated from the New Castle High School, Mercersburg Academy and Princeton University in 1943. He left immediately following graduation for Fort Sill, where he received further training in Artillery. In September of 1944 he was sent overseas and served as a forward observer with the Artillery. In October 1944 he was seriously wounded and was a patient in an English hospital until February 1945, when he returned to active combat duty. Word received by his mother from the War Department stated he was killed in Germany on February 27th.
