

Buried at: Plot D Row 8 Grave 14 Luxembourg American Cemetery Luxembourg City, Luxembourg

Awards: Air Medal with 4 Oak Leaf Clusters

1LT Schoeneck was piloting an L-4 observation plane observing the battles for Bourcy and Rachamps with 2LT Jack S. Terry (FA OCS Class 24-42) serving as an aerial observer looking for enemy tanks and hidden artillery positions. They were reportedly shot down when the plane ran into the path of a friendly artillery shell while flying in support of the 327th Glider Infantry Regiment.
