



BRIGADIER GENERAL ANSON W. SCHULZ

After graduating from Officer Candidate School, Brigadier General Schulz served with the 8th Missile Battalion, 15th Artillery in various positions including Firing Battery Commander. He was then stationed in Europe with the 3rd Missile Battalion, 7th Artillery. Next, during his first tour in Vietnam, he served at USARV Headquarters as Chief of the Commercial Entertainment Branch, and later G-3 Air Advisor, MACV. A second tour in Vietnam as a District Senior Advisor with MACV Team 66 was followed by an assignment as S-3 Operations Officer of an Air Defense Battalion at Fort Hood, Texas.

Brigadier General Schulz was the Assistant Professor of Military Science at the University of Tampa and then attended the Command and General Staff College prior to obtaining a Masters Degree in Russian History from the University of Kansas. He later served as a Military Intelligence Officer, Air Defense Battalion Commander, Weapons Branch Chief and Executive Officer, 11th Air Defense Group. His next assignment was as Chief of Staff, G-3 (Operations), 32nd Army Air Defense Command, USAREUR. Later at Fort Bliss he was the TRADOC System Manager of the Patriot Weapon System. His career culminated as Deputy Director, Strategic Defense Initiative Organization at the Pentagon.

Brigadier General Schulz's decorations and awards include the Legion of Merit (with Oak Leaf Cluster), the Bronze Star (with Oak Leaf Cluster), the Meritorious Service Medal (five Oak Leaf Clusters), the Air Medal, the Army Commendation Medal and the Combat Infantryman Badge.
