Colonel Shubuck's initial assignment was at Fort Benning, Georgia. He served as a Training Officer in Company E, and later as the Commander of Company C, 2nd Battalion, 1st Brigade, United States Army Training Center, Infantry. After attending the MATA Course at Fort Bragg, North Carolina he served in IV Corps with U. S. Army Military Assistance Command Vietnam.

Colonel Shubuck then served as S-1 and S-4, 3rd Battalion, 51st Artillery, Highlands New Jersey, prior to attending Embry Riddle Aeronautical University. He was discharged in 1971 and returned to the civilian sector. He held various management positions including the U.S. Director of Dealer Operations for a Canadian company called Tidy Car.

His military career resumed in August 1982 with the New York Army National Guard. Colonel Shubuck then served as Company Commander, Headquarters and Headquarters, 221st Engineer Group, and later as Group S-4. Subsequent assignments were as Executive Officer, 152nd Engineer Battalion and later S-3, 221st Engineer Group. His career culminated as the Executive Officer, Engineer Brigade, 42nd Infantry Division. He retired from the New York Army National Guard on 1 March 1996.

Colonel Shubuck's decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal (two Oak Leaf Clusters), and the Army Commendation Medal (two Oak Leaf Clusters).
