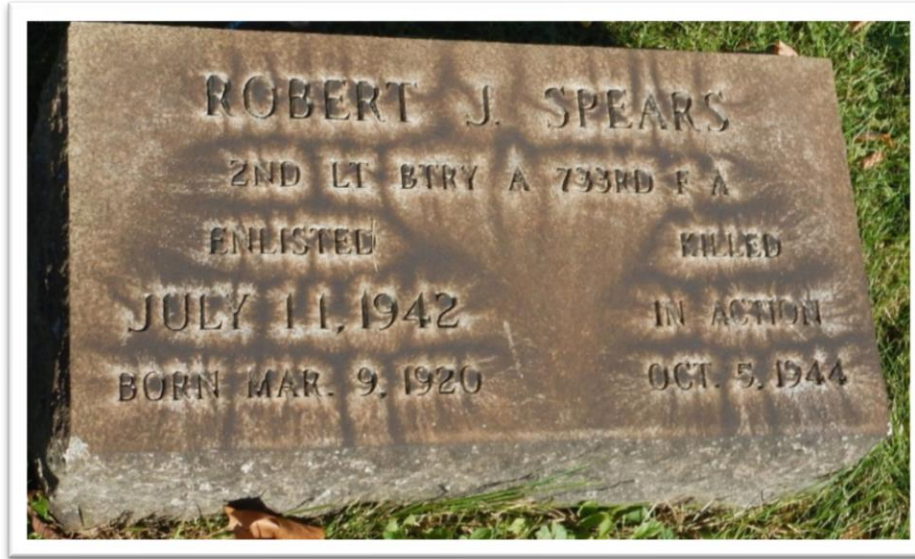

Lieutenant Dies Of Wounds Overseas

Lieutenant Robert J. Spears, 24, husband of Mrs. Jean Weinkauf Spears of 2714 Graham boulevard, died of wounds received in France on October 5, his wife announced yesterday.

A graduate of Wilkinsburg High school and Allegheny College, where he was a member of Alpha Chi Rho fraternity, Lieutenant Spears, field artilleryman, entered service in June, 1942, and was overseas since April. He leaves his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Robert L. Spears of Shelbourne avenue, and a sister, Mrs. Harold C. Leimer of Little Rock, Ark.
