The 335th Field Artillery Battalion was redesignated 764th Field Artillery Battalion (USAR) 30 March 1955. Was promoted to grade of Lieutenant Colonel 3 July 1957. The 764th Field Artillery Battalion was redesignated 3d Howitzer Battalion (8")(SP) 83d Artillery 1 June 1959.

Colonel Stotts commanded same unit for 16 years, from 13 August 1954 to 23 August 1970, at which time he was promoted to Colonel and, because of grade, had to relinquish command.

On 1 July 1971, Colonel Stotts assumed command of the 40th Ordnance Group (Ammo) (DS/GS), Jackson, Mississippi.
