Colonel Sullivan served as a Platoon Leader in the Officer Candidate School Brigade for one year after graduating from OCS. He was then assigned to Headquarters 13th Combat Aviation Battalion Vietnam as the Assistant Airfield Commander prior to serving with Military Assistance Command Vietnam (MACV) Team 96 as Assistant Battalion Artillery Advisor.

He commanded a Basic Training Company at Fort Knox and then served a second tour in Vietnam with 7th Battalion, 13th Field Artillery where he was the Assistant S-3, prior to Battery Command. He was then assigned to the U.S. Army Signal Center at Fort Monmouth as an Instructor in the Tactics Division. Subsequent assignments included Assistant Battalion S-2 and Nuclear Surety Team Chief, VII Corps Artillery, Germany.

He later commanded an Artillery Battery in the Ohio National Guard, served with the 5030th U.S. Army Reserve School as an Instructor at the Command and General Staff College. He was Chief, Schools Division and later Chief Training Division, Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff Training, 123rd Army Reserve Command. He then served as the Assistant Deputy Chief of Staff Training for the 123rd and culminated his career as the Deputy Chief of Staff for Resource Management.

Colonel Sullivan's Decorations include the Bronze Star Medal with three Oak-Leaf Clusters, the Army Commendation Medal with two Oak-Leaf Clusters and the Meritorious Service Medal.
