Colonel Tenore's initial assignment was Gun Platoon Officer, B Battery, 36th 120mm Gun Anti-Aircraft Artillery Battalion, Fort Meade, Maryland. He then served as Assistant Platoon Leader D Battery, 15th Anti-Aircraft Artillery Automatic Weapons Battalion, and Forward Observer/Motor Officer 7th Infantry Division Artillery, Korea.

He served as Assistant Battalion S-3, 538th Field Artillery Battalion and Commander A Battery 3rd Battalion, 28th Artillery in Germany. Later he was an Instructional Literature Writer, Office of Training Literature, Fort Sill. Colonel Tenore's other assignments included Management Analyst and Briefer first at the Army Comptroller Office and later at the Office of the Army Chief of Staff at the Pentagon. He also commanded the 7th Battalion, 17th Artillery, 2nd Infantry Division, Korea.

He later served as Chief of Management Headquarters, Pacific Command, Executive Assistant to the Chief of Staff CINCPAC and Chief of Performance Evaluation, Headquarters Pacific Command, Camp Smith Hawaii. His career culminated as Comptroller, Military Traffic Management Command, Washington, D.C.

Colonel Tenore's decorations include the Legion of Merit (with Oak Leaf Cluster), the Bronze Star, the Army Commendation Medal (with Oak Leaf Cluster), the Korean Service Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal and the Armed Force Expeditionary Medal.
