According to George Koskimaki's *Battered Bastards of Bastogne*: 2LT Terry was observing the battles for Bourcy and Rachamps, looking for enemy tanks and hidden artillery positions in an L-4 observation piloted by 1LT George Schoeneck (FAOCS Class 69-43). They were reportedly shot down when the plane ran into the path of a friendly artillery shell.
