

COLONEL PAUL TREOLO, JR.

Colonel Treolo joined the Army in 1960, attended Jump School and later served with the 173rd Airborne Brigade in Vietnam in 1965 where he was promoted to Staff Sergeant. He attended Flight School at Fort Walters and Fort Rucker after graduating from OCS. He then served with the 35th Field Artillery Group in Bamberg Germany as an S-2/Aviator. His next assignment was in Vietnam with the 163rd Aviation Company, 101st Airborne Division as Operations Officer and Executive Officer. He then served as the S-4 and Battery Commander, 1st Battalion, 320th Field Artillery, 82nd Airborne Division, followed by an assignment to the 82nd Aviation Battalion as the Executive Officer and Company Commander.

He then served as Executive Assistant to the Pacific Command Chief of Staff and later the Battalion Executive Officer, 3rd Battalion, 13th Field Artillery. He was then assigned as the Senior Advisor to the 227th Field Artillery Brigade, Miami Florida, prior to assuming Command of the 2nd, Battalion, 2nd Field Artillery, Fort Sill. After attending the Naval War College, he served as the Chief of Staff Headquarters V Corps Artillery in Frankfurt Germany. His career culminated as Director, Training Operations, Headquarters TRADOC.

Colonel Treolo's decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal (with two Oak-Leaf Clusters), the Air Medal (10 awards), and the Army Commendation Medal (with two Oak-Leaf Clusters).
