Colonel Ulmer served a tour a tour of duty as an infantryman with the 173rd Airborne Brigade prior to attending Officer Candidate School. After graduation he was assigned to the 3rd Special Forces Group at Fort Bragg, North Carolina as a HALO Detachment Commander and Assistant S-3.

He then served as Detachment Executive Officer and later Detachment Commander of Company C, 3rd Battalion, 11th Special Forces Group, Winston-Salem, North Carolina. After an assignment as Adjutant of the 11th Special Forces Group he commanded the 108th Training Division, USAR Infantry School and later served as a brigade G-3 Test Officer. Subsequent assignments included Unit Readiness Officer and Adjutant with the 1st SOCOM Augmentation Detachment at Fort Bragg and Plans and Operations G-3, Special Forces Command.

During the Gulf War he served as Deputy Chief Coalition Warfare Branch with the 352nd Civil Affairs Command, the 96th Civil Affairs Command, and the 5th Special Forces Group in Saudi Arabia, Kuwait and Iraq. His career culminated as the Deputy G-1, United States Army Special Forces Command, Fort Bragg.

Colonel Ulmer's decorations include the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star, the Purple Heart, the Meritorious Service Medal, the Air Medal, the Army Commendation Medal (with V-device) and the Combat Infantryman's Badge.
