

BRIGADIER GENERAL BRIAN D. WINTER CLASS 13-70

Brigadier General Winter served as a forward observer with 1st Battalion, 8th Field Artillery 25th Infantry Division in Vietnam and a Training Officer for a Basic Combat Training Company at Fort Dix prior to release from active duty.

He then served with the 140th and 136th Field Service Company Fort Totten, New York, the 133rd Field Artillery, Texas National Guard and commanded a battery in the 1st Battalion, 136th Field Artillery, Ohio National Guard. He also served as the Battalion S-3 and later Brigade Fire Support Officer for the 1st Battalion, 136th Field Artillery.

In the Kansas National Guard, he served as Deputy Fire Support Coordinator (DFSCOORD) 35th Infantry Division Artillery and commanded the 2nd, Battalion, 130th Field Artillery, prior to assuming duty as the Division Artillery S-3. His next assignment was DFSCOORD, 42nd^d Infantry Division Artillery, New York Army National Guard followed by command of the 209th Field Artillery Brigade. He next served as Deputy Commander (Support), 42nd Infantry Division. He later commanded the 27th Infantry Brigade and culminated his career as the Deputy Commander (Maneuver), 42nd Infantry Division.

Brigadier General Winters' awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star, the Meritorious Service Medal w/5 OLC and the Army Commendation medal w/ 3 OLC.
