

Colonel Charles R. Wise Class 503-68

Colonel Wise trained in the Redeye Missile System at the Air Defense School, Fort Bliss and served in Germany with VII Corps Field Artillery as a Communications Officer. He was then assigned to the 2nd General Hospital, U.S. Army Europe, where he served in the Support and Service Division and later Branch Transferred to the Medical Service Corps.

He attended the Medical Material and Service Management Course at the Medical Field Service School at Fort Sam Houston, Texas. He then served a tour in Vietnam with the 85th Evacuation Hospital at Phi Bai and the 95th Evacuation Hospital at Danang.

After attending the Army Medical Officer Advanced Course, he served a tour with USA MEDDAC Thailand as Supply and Service Division Chief and a Medical Detachment Support Officer. He left active duty in 1979 after a three-year assignment with the 7th Medical Command, Nurnberg, Germany.

He transferred to the Army Reserves and served in a series of assignments with the 3747th U.S. Army Reserve School in Europe, including Instructor at the Command and General Staff Officer Course, School Secretary, Personnel Officer and Director of Enlisted Courses. He transferred to the 4th Medical Brigade where his assignments included Chief of Staff, Chief of Operations and Readiness Branch and Chief of the Materiel Support Division. He culminated his career as Commander of the 4th Medical Brigade. He retired from 21st Support Group in 1994, and remained an active reservist until retiring in 2003.

Colonel Wise's decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, the Joint Service Commendation Medal and the Meritorious Service Medal.
